COASTAL ANGLER COVER REQUIREMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

You'll have a much better chance of your photo being selected to be featured on the cover of Coastal Angler Magazine, The Angler Magazine, or our newest mag, The Angler Video Magazine, by making sure the requirements and recommendations listed below have been met.

- QUALITY: We receive many nice photos that are just too small for use on our covers. Photos submitted for cover consideration need to be as large as possible, taken at the highest possible camera setting. We need a photo that is roughly 10" wide by 12" in height at a resolution of 300 dpi (300 dots per inch).
- FRAMING: Vertical images are required for placement on our covers. Angler's head should be fully shown (not cropped in any way) with ample room above. Fish/species should also be in full view. Simple background surrounding the main person(s) and species is optimal.
- CONTENT: Your best bet for having your submitted photo contend for cover consideration, once the above two criteria have been met, is for there to be a happy (smiling) angler (or anglers) holding a species in the correct manner-not by the tail with the head facing down, or vice versa with the head up and the tail down.
